RE: Navigability Determination – 8613 State Highway 19, Town of Berry, Section 10 Parcel: 0807-102-8000-1

The Dane County Zoning Division has processed your request for a navigability determination for an intermittent stream that is mapped on your property at 8613 State Highway 19.

Before conducting the site inspection, the County G.I.S., aerial photography, and the Wisconsin Surface Water Data Viewer were used to determine the categorization of this intermittent stream. An intermittent stream is one that has a periodic or recurrent flow. The Dane County Land Conservation department provided a plan from 2009 for the installation of a grassed swale in this area.

A site inspection was conducted on March 4, 2020. It was observed that the grassed swale has been washed out south of State Highway 19 resulted in erosion of the waterway cutting down and discharging in Halfway Prairie Creek. While there was significant cut and flow created a defined bed and bank formation, the depth of the waterway was not significant enough for the floating of a craft.

After further review of the intermittent stream, it has been determined to be NOT navigable.

This letter serves as notice that the future development that will occur on the above-described lots is NOT within the Shoreland Zoning District as defined under Chapter 11, Dane County Code of Ordinances.
