RE: Navigability Determination – Parcel #0807-104-9610-0, Town of Berry

Dear Mr. & Mrs. Richards:

Thank you for contacting our office to request a navigability determination for your property located in Section 10, Town of Berry. We've completed our review of the waterway in question, and have determined that this stream is not navigable.

We reviewed the applicable U.S.G.S. Topographic map to determine the categorization of this waterway, which was an "intermittent stream". An intermittent stream is one that has a periodic or recurrent flow and is typically considered navigable.

In our review of GIS data and satellite maps staff determined on September 7, 2011 the navigability of the stream based upon images, elevations and contours associated with the land. It was determined that these areas on your parcel were drainage swells as they did not indicate a defined bed and bank. A waterway is navigable if it has a defined bed and banks and is able to float a recreational watercraft of the shallowest draft on a regularly recurring basis. The waterway in question does not meet this definition.
