RE: Navigability Determination – 6559 County Highway P, Section 33, Town of Dane

The Dane County Zoning Division has processed your request for a navigability determination for a waterway mapped on your property.

Before conducting the site inspection, the County G.I.S., aerial photography, and the Wisconsin Surface Water Data Viewer were used to determine the categorization of the waterway. The map showed an intermittent stream. An intermittent stream is one that has a periodic or recurrent flow.

A site inspection was conducted on December 19, 2024. It was observed that the mapped stream was located entirely within the roadside ditch of County Highway P. Culverts were present for driveway access to the property; the entire ditch was covered with terrestrial vegetation with no signs of erosive forces or standing water.

After further review of the waterway, it has been determined that it is non-navigable from its origin to at least a point south where the County Highway P eastern ditch intersects the western ditch via a culvert under the Highway. The status of the waterway downstream of this point was not evaluated as it was out of scope with this request.

This letter serves as notice that the future development that will occur on the above-described lot is <u>not</u> within the Shoreland Zoning District as defined under Chapter 11, Dane County Code of Ordinances and is therefore not subject to shoreland zoning regulations.
